Vision

The EU selected the Creative Economy as one of 14 strategic sectors for growth and resilient as well as inclusive societies.

By innovating Creative Economy, innovations by the Cultural and Creative Sectors and Industries (CCSI) will lead in shaping the twin transformations Europe faces, particularly during the Covid-19 recovery.

(EIT) will publish a call for the foundation of a Knowledge and Innovation Community (KIC). The ICE Consortium will participate in this tender aiming to found the KIC in 2023 in order to develop and scale innovation holistically - aesthetic, business, organizational, technological and social - through the Arts, Culture and Creative Economy. It has been supported by the State of North-Rhine Westphalia, German Ministry of Education and Research and 40 lead partners in 14 nations.



Five Year Growth in the CCSI*




Leading European Twin Transformations
